

TECA was developed in partnership by Computer Society staff and volunteers for the Test Technology Technical Council in order to support all of the society's TC's. Because updates are done online and are automatic, TECA promises to be a highly accurate, centralized repository for TC membership data and continuously improve services for the TC community.

Within this application, TC members may

- create, modify and renew TC memberships and services
- maintain current contact information for their TC memberships
- view their TC activities

TC officers may

- view TC membership data
- import new memberships
- extract mailing information for TC newsletters and related services

- In order to access TECA, you must have an IEEE Web Account username and password. (see below)
- You may join up to 4 Technical Committees at any time.
- TC memberships will automatically expire annually. Please return to TECA at least once a year to update your memberships. (Remember your Web Account login!)

- TECA requires that JavaScript be enabled in your browser and that you allow pop-ups for this domain.

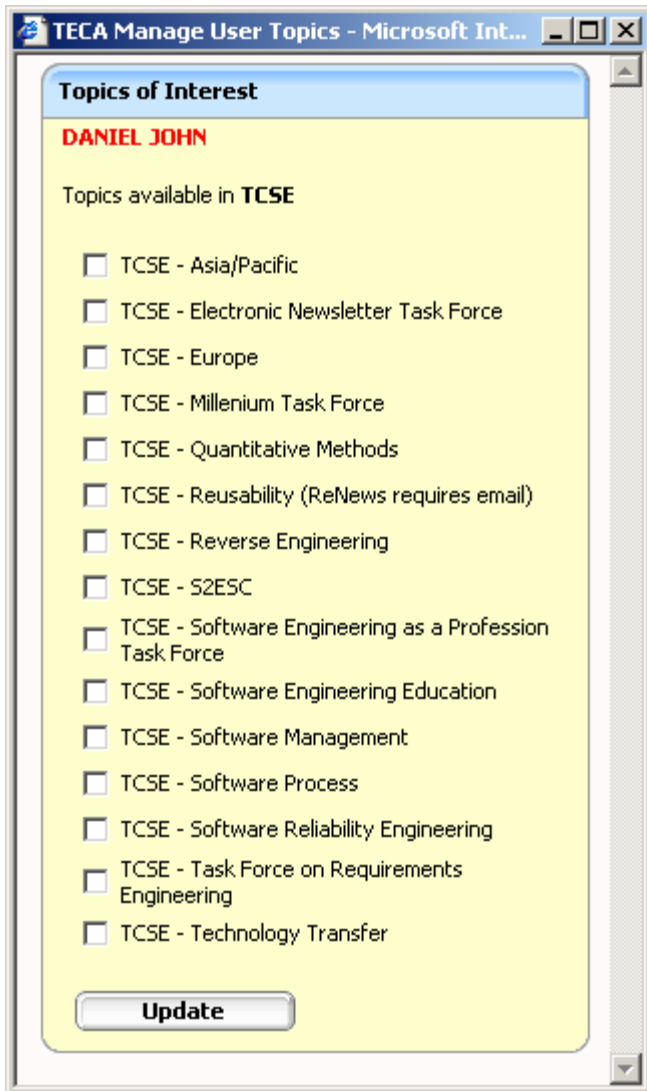
