IEEE Transactions on Computational Biology and Bioinformatics seeks original manuscripts for a Special Issue on Computational Intelligence Approaches in Computational Biology and Bioinformatics scheduled to appear in a **late 2006 issue**.

EXAMPLE: Application of biologically and linguistically inspired computational paradigms such as neural networks, evolutionary computation, and fuzzy systems and their hybridizations to problems in computational biology and bioinformatics have increased in recent years. This is likely due to demonstrated utility in handling complex mappings and imprecise information, and providing novel solutions to difficult problems without expert assistance.

This special issue aims to highlight application of these algorithms to biological problems. In this special issue, we encourage papers on novel computational intelligence algorithms (e.g., neural networks, evolutionary computation, fuzzy systems and their derivatives and combinations) applied to problems such as:

EXAMPLE:

- Sequence analysis
- Gene and protein expression analysis
- Protein structure and interaction prediction
- Regulatory networks and pathway analysis
- Gene, protein, and biomedical ontology
- Biological data mining, text mining, and rule extraction
- Biological and molecular image analysis
- Protein docking and drug discovery

Submitted articles must not have been previously published or currently submitted for journal publication elsewhere and must meet the requirements of IEEE copyright policy.
