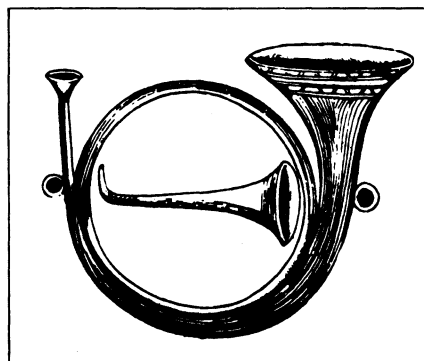


CALL FOR PAPERS
