- **CONFERENCE DIGESTS AND PROCEEDINGS**—Proceedings and digests produced by the dozens of symposia and major conferences in the United States and abroad, sponsored or co-sponsored by the Computer Society, are available from the Society's Publications Office. Significant discounts are available to members.
